Equine Flu – Northumberland County Show

Equine Influenza and Tetanus vaccinations are a compulsory requirement for all pony/horses attending the Northumberland County Show. The requirement for the first 3 vaccinations is as follows: the first 2 vaccinations 21 – 92 days apart, a third booster between 150-215 days, and an annual booster vaccination within 365 days thereafter. No horse should enter competitions within 7 days of an EI vaccination. This rule may be subject to change from guidance from the FEI/BEF and any changes will be notified via the www.northcountysideshow.co.uk website.

In-focal mares that have already had vaccinations of primary Equine Influenza course should be vaccinated 4-6 weeks before the foal is due to be born. Foals should be vaccinated for Equine Influenza at 6 months to commence their primary course.

We urge all owners to adhere to strict biosecurity protocols at all times.

PLEASE NOTE THAT NEITHER VACCINATION CERTIFICATES - NOR PASSPORTS SHOULD BE SENT TO THE SHOW OFFICE PRIOR TO THE EVENT. RANDOM CHECKS WILL BE CARRIED OUT ON THE SHOWGROUND DURING THE SHOW

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES 29th APRIL 2022 - NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED LIGHT HORSE SECTION – QUALIFICATIONS

B.S.P.S. This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (BSPS), and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the Rules of the BSPS, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

This Show is a qualifier for the 2022 B.S.P.S. Championships Show, to be held at Arena UK. The 1st and 2nd prize winners only in open classes in the following sections Show Ponies, Mini Show Ponies, Show Hunter, Working Hunter Ponies and Mini WHP and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Prize-winners in the Open Intermediate S.R.T.(including Mixed height) W.H. and S.H.T. and C.S. and in MIXED HEIGHT CLASSES the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th placed ponies will qualify for the B.S.P.S. Championships Show, provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rules 21 and 26 and ridden by a B.S.P.S. member. 1st and 2nd places in the nursery stakes class will qualify for the BSPS Summer Championship Show.

This show is a qualifier for the B.S.P.S. Blue Riband Pony of the Year, the 1st and 2nd prize winners in the Lead Rein, First Ridden OR Open Show Pony OR Open Working Hunter Pony OR Open Show Hunter Pony OR Open Intermediate WH SRT and SH Classes will qualify.

This Show is a qualifier for the B.S.P.S. Classic Services Group Challenge – see Rule 516. Animals competing in the following Open classes will qualify:- Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WHP, Intermediate SH, SRT and WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes.

ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW - This Show is a qualifier for the R.I.H.S. Only one pony in each of the three Open WHP, Nursery Stakes or Open Intermediate W.H, SR, SH classes qualifies, and the highest placed, (not already qualified), from the first THREE ponies placed in each class will qualify.

N.B. THE R.I.H.S. QUALIFICATION IS SUBJECT TO CONFIRMATION FROM B.S.P.S. HEAD OFFICE.

THE B.S.P.S. BINKS FAMILY CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS - This show is a qualifier for the B.S.P.S. Binks Family Champion of Champions the 1st prize winners in the following classes will qualify :- Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, WHP, Intermediate SH, SRT and WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes.

THE B.S.P.S. THE WHITE COMPANY CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS This show is a qualifier for The B.S.P.S. The White Company Mini WHP Champion of Champions the 1st prize winners in Open Cradle and Nursery Stakes will qualify.

Owners and riders see Rules must be B.S.P.S. Members before the date of the show to qualify in classes with qualification for BLUE RIBAND & R.I.H.S. and animals must be registered with the B.S.P.S. Membership forms and payment must be received in the office no later than the last working day (Monday to Friday) prior to the date of the qualifying show. (See Rule 20)

National Pony Society (NPS) S4.099

NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 2nd – 4th August 2022.

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final.

Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Corscaron Horse Essentials Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards **MUST** be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a **Qualifying or Life member** of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Affiliation No. 22-013

Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However in order to Qualify both Owner and Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current showing member and have a valid Qualifier card. Members to apply to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card.

The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 11th-13th August 2022.

For full rulings and information on competition/qualification, please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members Handbook; or visit www.chapsuk.com. Only "coloured" horses and ponies (as defined in the Current CHAPS UK Members' Handbook) may compete in these classes.

All Stallions, 4 years old and over must be graded with CHAPS UK in order to compete in these classes and must wear their CHAPS UK Stallion Disc without exception.

Caledonian Showing Championships



This show is a qualifier for the Caledonian Showing Championships, which offers competitors the opportunity to compete at a top level Championship Final in Scotland. With a draped main arena, amazing rosettes, special prizes, music, judges from the south and atmospheric Evening Performances, this is the show everyone wants to be part of, and has grown and grown, so for 2022 is now running as a three day show. This year's show will be held at Highfield @ Howe, near Ladybank, Fife on 14/15/16 October 2022

Every horse & pony placed 1st in all Inhand, Ridden Showing classes (not fun classes) & Working Hunter/Pony classes will qualify to compete in any appropriate class at the Finals. All Champions & Reserves will qualify for the Champion & Reserves Stakes Finals. Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line.

All qualified horses and ponies will be listed on the Caledonian Showing Championship Show's website www.caledonianchampionships.webs.com (and soon to come www.caledonianchampionships.co.uk where you will also find a regularly updated list of qualifying shows and a wealth of other information.

This show is a qualifier for the TSR NAF Five Star Showing Finals. All In Hand & Ridden classes are qualifiers. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals! The 4 highest placed handlers/riders will qualify in each class. Competitors **MUST** have their qualification record sheet signed by judge/steward/secretary, record sheets are available **FREE** from the TSR website.

Mare or gelding 4yrs old or over and of any height. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1st January 2022. Horses to be ridden in any suitable bridle and should be plaited. All entries must be registered with RoR and HAVE raced in GB. Racing injuries and blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series

The first three go forward to the final at The Jockey Club RoR National Championships, Aintree, 27th August 2022. The judge will NOT ride. Horses may be stripped for conformation at the discretion of the judge. **Competitors must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap.** All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time in force. The class to be judged **50%** jumping, **20%** Style while jumping and performance and **30%** awarded for show, manners and suitability to be retrained.

PHASE 1 Jumping to be judged: 8 rustic jumps 3 foot (90cm) to 3 foot 3 inches (1 metre) with a maximum spread of 95cm) The following points to be deducted at the end of each jumping round: 10 points to be deducted for a knock down. 15 points to be deducted for a refusal. 20 points for second refusal. Elimination for third refusal or fall.

PHASE 2 Class returns without boots and judged for an individual show/conformation. (In some classes, at the judge's discretion, horses might be asked to do a 'show' following their jumping without leaving the ring. This is often the case with a large number in the class). Each horse to complete an individual show of no longer than 1 ½ minutes. Show to include the following movements: Walk, Trot, canter showing change of leg, extended canter (gallop) halt and stand, walk off on long rein. Total marks out of 30% for Show, manners and suitability to be retrained. Fences for the final at Aintree can be up to a maximum of 3'6" (1.05 metre)

E98 - Tattersalls RoR Scottish Open Show Series Qualifier 2022

Thoroughbred mare or gelding, 4years old or over, any height. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1st January of the calendar year holding the classes. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavesson noseband. Horses should be plaited. The first three go forward to the championship at the Royal Highland Show 2023. In the event that the first three are already qualified, the qualification will go down the line to fourth. All entries MUST have current competition registration with the RoR and have RACED in GB. There will be a prize for the highest placed veteran 15 years or over. The class will be run under the rules of RoR. Horses to be ridden by the judge. All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time in force. Competitors must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap. Racing injuries and blemishes will NOT be ignored in this series.

E99 - HCR Ridden Ex Racehorse - horses 4 years old and over, any sex. Riders 14 years and over.

E100 - HCR In hand Ex Racehorse - horses any age and sex, handlers to be 14 years and over.

The Horse & Country Racehorses (HCR) series is open to Thoroughbreds who have raced, trained or been bred to race. Racing injuries will be ignored providing the horse is sound. Riders must be 14 years plus, ridden horses must be 4 years plus and veterans are 12 years plus. Judges will not ride and you will not be asked to gallop as a ride but maybe asked to gallop in your individual show.

To compete at the HCR championships, the handler/rider and horse must be registered with HCR. Members must carry their cards in the ring for signing at qualifying shows and be placed 1st-4th (qualifications may be passed down to 6th place). Non-members must send their qualification cards (presented by the judge), fees and register with HCR before the closing date for entries for the HCR Championship show at Netherton Equestrian on Sunday 11th September 2022.
